5. *** **PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD** *** one lucky girl from each age group will receive "The People's Choice award." a \$1.00 donation per vote will be collected for your favorite contestant. The contestant with the most votes will receive a trophy.
6. *******Rehearsal is mandatory (if you are not present, you will not compete!)** rehearsal will be held in the Appomattox County High School Auditorium at the following times: **Tiny Miss, Little Miss, and Petite Miss Contestants: Sunday, Sept. 9th at 2pm. Jr. Miss, Teen Miss, and Miss Contestants: Sunday, Sept. 9th, 2018 at 4pm.**
7. **Pageant will be held at the Appomattox County High School auditorium September 16, 2018 at 2:00** pm, doors open at 12:00 Noon. Contestant and one parent admitted free of charge. Admission to the event will be \$5.00 per person, children 10 and under free. Light concessions will be for sale in the lobby area. NO Drinks or Food inside the Auditorium.
8. Winners will be entered in the Historic Appomattox Railroad Festival Parade October 13, 2018. Winners are responsible for car, driver, and posters for the parade. Meet and greet with the event Band, winner introductions during the street dance.
9. Winners will have pictures taken and submitted to the Times Virginian Newspaper.

Rules for Miss Historic Appomattox Railroad Festival

Rules for Little Miss Historic Appomattox Railroad Festival

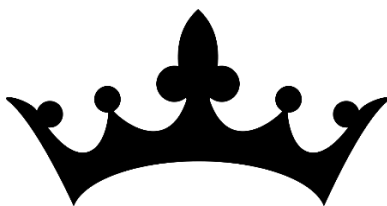
1. Little Miss must be 5-6 years old by sept. 1, 2018.
