We hope you plan to join us at this year's festival! Below are the general guidelines and rules for participation in the 2024 Historic Appomattox Railroad Festival. Please read them carefully. The Historic Appomattox Railroad Festival committee cordially invites you to participate in the 52^{nd} annual Festival to be held October 12 - 13, 2024. Each year the Festival is becoming better and attracting more and more visitors. We hope you plan to join us at this year's Festival! Below are the general guidelines and rules for participation in the 2024 Historic Appomattox Railroad Festival. Please read them carefully.

Participation:

If you are not a returning vendor or have changed or display, items sold, distributed, or on display they must be approved by the Festival Committee. A website or photograph of your work/items being sold in your display must accompany your application. If this information is not provided with your application, your application and fee will be returned to you.

Banned Items - No Exceptions:

- Pets
- Generators
- Yard sale or flea market type items
- Items with profanity
- Snap pops or any other item containing explosive material

- Air guns, BB guns, pellet guns, etc.
- Knives, blades, weapons
- · Alcohol or Drugs
- Any other item deemed necessary for removal by any member of HARF

Where:

Check in at the corner of Morton Lane and Court Street on the Saturday morning of the event. GPS address is 339 Court Street, Appomattox, 24522.

Vendors should be completely set up with **vehicles removed before the opening of each day's event.** It is not required to tear down and re-set up between Saturday night and Sunday morning, however there is no guarantee of vendors' spot not being disturbed. Additional Notes About Payment:

Any entries received after September 30th may be declined.

- 1. Due to PayPal fees, the early bird special does **NOT** apply to online payments.
- 2. Non-profit organizations are required to provide tax ID# on page 1 of the application.

Electricity:

Electricity is available, but limited to first come first served. (Based on receipt of application.)

Space:

- Approximately 10' by 12' space.
- Vendors must provide their own tables, chairs, tents, display equipment and anything else needed throughout the Festival. Vendors are required to allow way for the parade route and Railroad Willie Express. After the parade your tent may be moved back on to the street. See page 1 re spaces on Main Street.
- Spaces will be marked prior to the Festival. You will receive your space number at the time of registration on the day of the festival. **Entrances to buildings and storefronts must remain open**. No material is to be displayed or hung on buildings, windows, or street lamps. Vendors are responsible for keeping the area clean and free of hazards. Vehicles must be parked outside of festival grounds.

Refunds:

For any reason you will not be able to participate in the festival and you have already paid your fee, you must notify the festival committee no later than September 11, 2024 to receive a refund. **After this time, no refunds will be given for any reason.**

Tax Collection:

Vendors are responsible for collecting, filing and reporting sales tax collected

Map:

A map of the festival events is available at www.appomattoxrrfest.org/map. This map will be updated periodically, but will be available for you the week before the event. Please familiarize yourself with available parking, restroom locations and the flow of traffic to ensure a positive experience.

Setup Information:

- You must check in at the registration table to receive your vendor space information.
- Saturday set up at 6:00am to 8:30am
- All vehicles must be off the street by 8:30am
- Sunday set up is 9:00am to 11:30am
- All vehicles must be off the street by 11:30am

The Historic Appomattox Railroad Festival committee cannot and will not assume any responsibility for any lost, damaged, stolen or destroyed work, material or equipment attended or unattended during the Festival. Anything left throughout the night will be left at your own risk.
